In February we will start the month making predictions about the groundhog and talking about how shadows work. We hope we get some snow before spring comes so we can



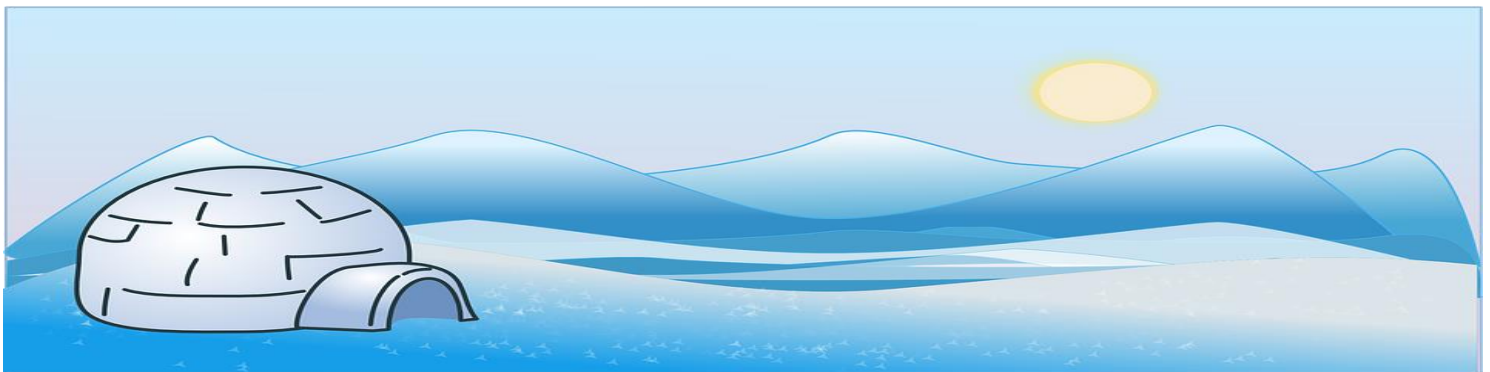
